**LUGGAGE**

Baggage handling for one piece of luggage per person is included in the tour cost. Carry-On bags are limited to a small handbag or tote (no wheels) for which you will be responsible for handling. Additional luggage will incur a charge per piece.

**GRATUITY GUIDELINES**

Gratuities to your Tour Manager, Coach Driver, or Step-On Guides are not included in the tour package. These gratuities are at your discretion and should be extended personally and individually. Below is a guideline for gratuity amounts:
