### HOTEL TRANSFER (ARRIVAL)

Taxi: Approximately \$44  
Taxis can be found on the lower roadway, outside of baggage claim. Proceed to the 3rd island

UberX: Approximately \$29

Rideshares are located on Island 2 outside of baggage claim.

**LUGGAGE**
