

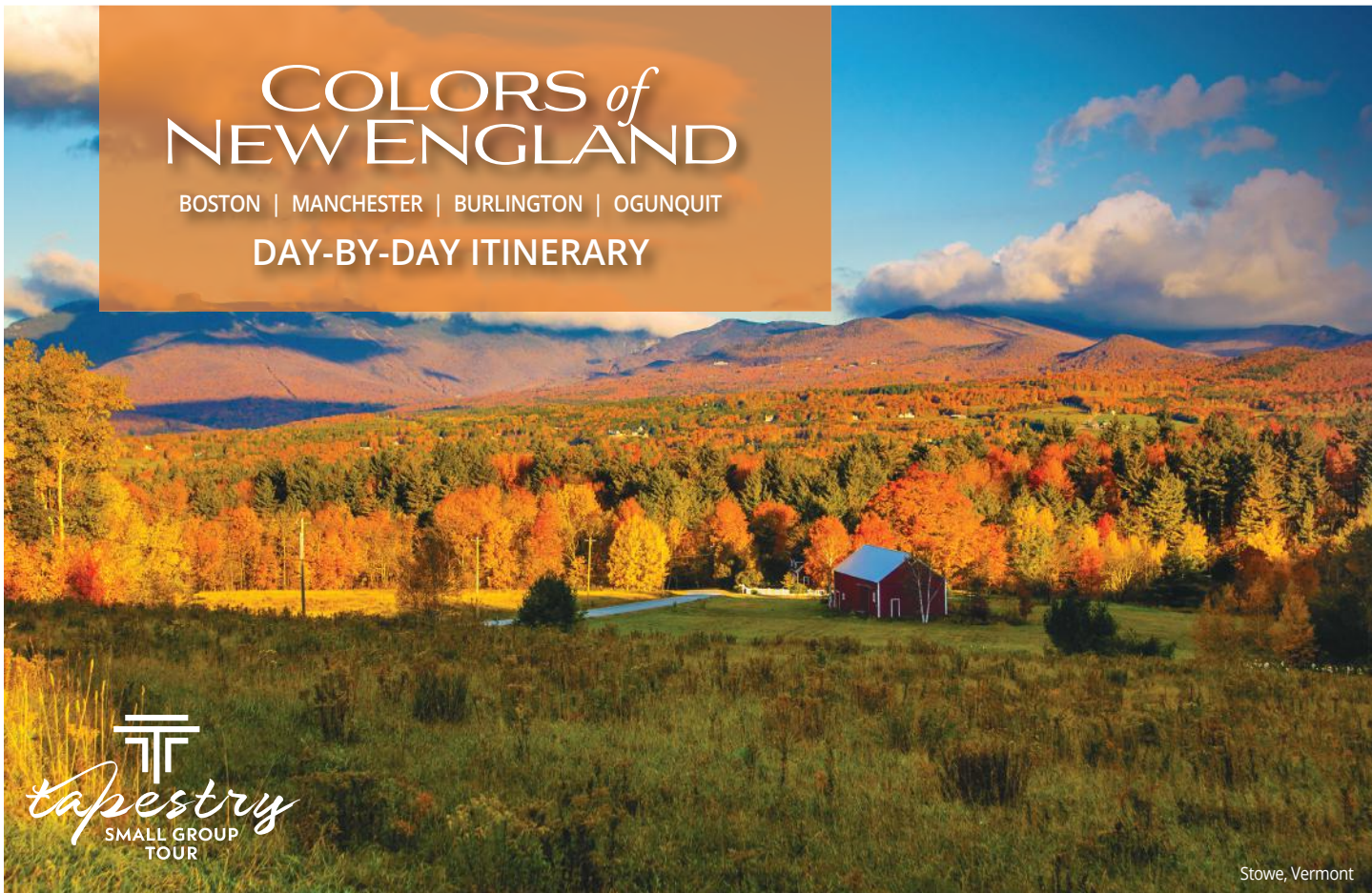

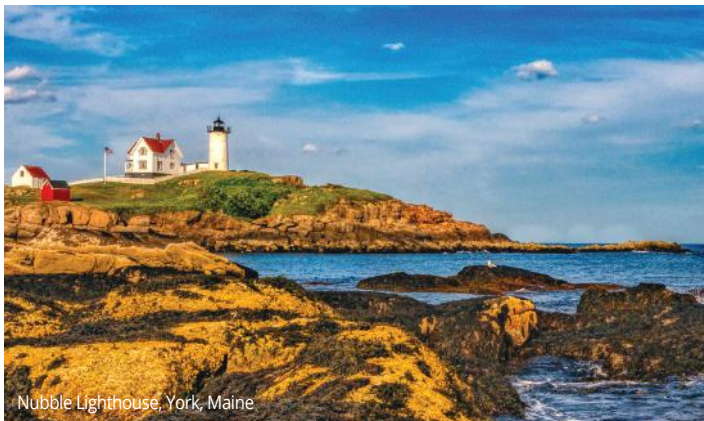
DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1 ARRIVE BOSTON – TOUR BEGINS

DAY 4 BURLINGTON – STOWE

DAY 5 BURLINGTON – MONTPELIER – WOODSTOCK – OGUNQUIT
