DAY 4 SAVANNAH

With more than 3,500 bolts, including batiks, lace, and heirloom fabrics, you'll be spoilt for choice. After enjoying lunch at your own pace, you'll embark on a **city tour** of the stunning **St. Simons Island**, offering scenic views and a tranquil atmosphere. As the day winds down, a warm welcome awaits you at the **Jekyll Island Club Hotel & Resort**, your home for the next two nights. This **National Historic Landmark**, featuring Tiffany's leaded glass in the Grand Dining Room, provides the perfect setting for an evening of relaxation, perhaps with a mint julep in hand, epitomizing the Southern way of life. ⁽³⁾

DAY 6 JEKYLL ISLAND

After breakfast, set off on the **Jekyll Island Tram Ride** to delve into the rich history of this island, once known as a Millionaires' Playground.
