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DAY 1 ARRIVE CHARLESTON – TOUR BEGINS

The remainder of the afternoon is yours to enjoy Savannah at your own pace. Tonight, gather with your fellow travelers for a **special Farewell Dinner**. Raise a glass, savor the flavors of the South, and celebrate the wonderful places, creative discoveries, and new friendships that have made this journey one to remember. ③ ①
